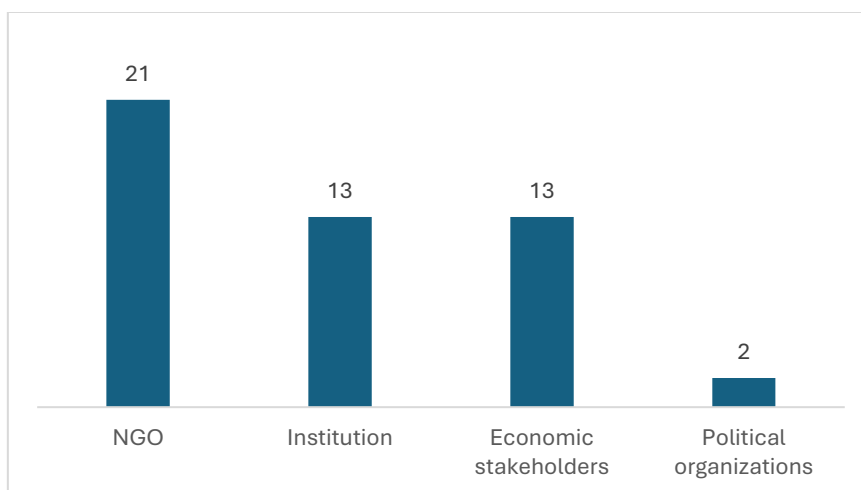


Figure 1. Number of stakeholders identified in our contact database per type

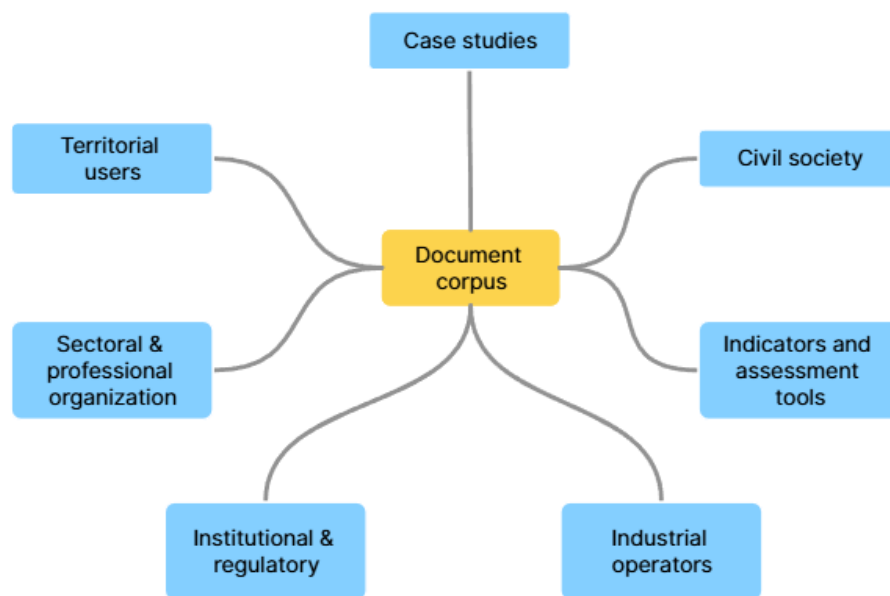


Figure 2. Typology of grey literature documents
